Terrorist organisation live on Twitch.

NO, we can't report them. Twitch ignoring us. They say: "Sorry, nothing against our rules" via bot in emails.

The main goal is to create a **news hook that Twitch won't be able to just ignore**, as it has always done with Alabuga.

Ukrainian civilians are being killed by these drones, while on Twitch they're hosting a "CS2 tournament" on behalf of the terrorists. Today is the hardest day for the city of Dnipro, which has been under attack by these very drones for nearly a day now.

"Alabuga Polytechnic" (Alabuga Special Economic Zone), an entity currently under US, EU, and UK sanctions for its direct involvement in manufacturing military drones for the Russian Federation's invasion of Ukraine. Advertising a sanctioned military-linked entity violates Twitch's Terms of Service regarding illegal content and global compliance laws.

Evidence supporting the complaint against the "Alabuga Polytechnic" advertisement on Twitch:

1. Alabuga: A Manufacturer of Military Drones for Russia's Invasion of Ukraine.

The Alabuga Special Economic Zone (SEZ) operates under a contract with the Russian military, manufacturing Iranian Shahed-136 drones for use in the war against Ukraine. In December 2023, as the production became increasingly prominent, the United States and the European Union began imposing sanctions on entities linked to the Alabuga Special Economic Zone. This facility in Tatarstan has become Russia's main production site for Shahed drones, which are being used as the primary long-range strike weapon in the war against Ukraine.

2. Alabuga Polytechnic is directly involved in drone production

Alabuga Polytechnic has been in operation since 2019 and is a technical educational institution that enrolls Russian students aged 15–16. After the full-scale invasion began, JSC Alabuga's priorities shifted—students were enlisted to address the acute labor shortage at the new factory producing Shahed-136 drones for the Russian armed forces.

More than 90% of participants in the Start program and about a third of Polytechnic students are involved in drone production, primarily of the Shahed-136 model. According to JSC Alabuga's 2023

plans, Shahed drone production was expected to employ more than 1,000 workers per day shift, at least 70% of whom were to come from Alabuga Polytechnic and Alabuga Start.

In March 2023, the SEZ sent staff and students from Alabuga Polytechnic University to Iran to learn how to manufacture drone airframes.

3. U.S. Sanctions (OFAC/SDN List)

On February 23, 2024, OFAC, in conjunction with the State Department, targeted Alabuga's drone procurement network. The Russian company JSC "Alabuga Special Economic Zone of Industrial and Production Type" (SEZ Alabuga) received contracts from the Russian military to assemble Geran-2 drones supplied from Iran.

The Alabuga Special Economic Zone (SEZ) used underage students from an affiliated polytechnic university as laborers to assemble attack drones under appalling conditions. CEO Timur Shagivaleev has been implicated in the exploitation of these underage students.

4. EU Sanctions

Under the latest European Union sanctions, companies with ties to EU countries were required to leave the Alabuga SEZ by January 25, 2026—this is in accordance with the restrictions adopted in October 2025 as part of the 19th sanctions package.

5. UK Sanctions and General Confirmation of the Trilateral Regime

The United States, the United Kingdom, and the EU have imposed sanctions on the Alabuga Special Economic Zone; the United States has also imposed sanctions on affiliated companies and individuals holding key positions.

6. Scale of Production (Additional Context)

Satellite images from July 2025 show a massive expansion of the Alabuga SEZ—hundreds of new residential buildings and dozens of new industrial facilities. This influx of thousands of new workers and the construction of these facilities will enable Alabuga to dramatically ramp up production of drones intended, in the near term, to strike Ukraine's civilian population and infrastructure.

7. Violation of Twitch's rules

Twitch explicitly prohibits “the use of Twitch Services for any unlawful purpose”—this is stipulated in Section 10, subsection xvii, "Prohibited Conduct" of the Terms of Service.

Here is the exact quote from the official document: "use the Twitch Services for **any illegal purpose**, or in violation of any local, state, national, or international law or regulation, including without limitation laws governing intellectual property and other proprietary rights, data protection, and privacy."

All claims can be verified: sanctions imposed by the U.S., the EU, and the UK have been officially recorded; Alabuga Polytechnic's role in the production of combat drones has been documented by journalistic investigations and analytical institutions (ISIS, Iran Watch, CNN, Kyiv Independent); and the prohibition on illegal use is explicitly stated in Twitch's Terms of Service.
